The majority of the clinic players were newcomers at the event. The group had a tough time learning new skills in the heat, which made it for some difficult to keep hold of their club during the swing practices.

One club even made it farther than quite some golf balls at the driving range. Michiel Meijer won the clinic competition consisting of three elements: swing, pitching and putting. Winning golf lessons, next year Michiel is expected to play in the 18hole competition.

It was the second time the stableford competition was played at the North and East holes of the Nunspeetse golfcourse "Het Rijk van Nunspeet". Although the average score of the much smaller group in 2003 was sig-

nificantly higher, this year's top scores had more points than three years ago. With 39 stableford points Steve Netto was the proud winner of the Hans Minnee Challenge Trophy. In his acceptance speech Steve commemorated Hans Minnee, co-founder of VZM 10 years ago.

## The Hans Minnee Challenge Trophy


